- IV. SENIORS** – If you are planning to use A+ grant money after graduation, you need to file the FAFSA, you can file online at www.fafsa.ed.gov , and boys must register for the Selective Service when you reach 18 years of age.
- V. SENIORS** – Okay, we are on the last leg of the scholarships that are available. Below are listed April scholarships. Do not sign up and take an application if you do not intend on turning it back in to the counselor's office. Make sure you read the requirements of the scholarships also. Some have specific areas of study, essays, etc. Please pay close attention to the due dates for these scholarships. We do not want you to miss out on getting free money.
- VI. SENIORS** – The following scholarships are available in the counselor's office and must be turned back in to the counselor's office by noon on the day that they are due. Mrs. Beezley will take your applications even before the due date.
Terri L. Bruner Music Scholarship – due April 6th, must be pursuing a degree in music, 2.75 GPA and a 500 word essay on "Why you want to pursue a career in music."
Dent County Livestock Education Scholarship – due April 12th, must be majoring in the field of agriculture, 3 letters of recommendation.
Mark Voss Memorial Scholarship – due April 13th, open to FFA members
McDonald's Scholarship – due April 16th, open to McDonald's employees only.
Sharon Lorts Memorial Scholarship – April 13th, open to anyone, must have at least a 3.00 GPA, three letters of recommendation.
Urban Flight & Rural Needs Scholarship- due April 15th, must have a GPA of 2.50 and be pursuing a teaching degree
St. James Alumni Scholarship (4yr. applications and 2yr. applications—make sure you pick up the correct application) – due April 16th, must have a 3.00 GPA.
Phelps County Livestock Association – due April 16th, must have a 3.00 GPA and pursuing a degree in Agriculture.
Bushie Memorial Scholarship – due April 16th, must be majoring in education or nursing.
American Legion Scholarships including:
Lillie Lois Ford Scholarship – due April 17th, must be a descendant of a veteran and must have attended Boys or Girls State.
Joseph J. Frank Scholarship – due April 17th, must be a descendant of a member of the American Legion, American Legion Auxiliary, or Sons of the American Legion, and have attended Girls or Boys State.
M.D. Jack Murphy Memorial Nurses Scholarship – due April 17th, must be a descendant of a veteran and must be pursuing a Registered Nursing degree, be in the top 40% of class with a 2.0 GPA.
Charles L. Bacon Memorial Scholarship – due April 17th, must be an American Legion Family member, a member of the American Legion Auxiliary, or a member Sons of The American Legion or a descendant of any member thereof.
Erman W. Taylor Memorial Scholarship – due April 17th, must be a descendant of a veteran who served 90 or more days of active duty and having an honorable discharge. Must be pursuing a degree in education, must write a 500 word or less on "In your opinion, what was the most significant world event of 2009/2010".
USI Insurance Scholarship – due April 20th, open to anyone, must have at least a 3.00 GPA
Holocaust Remembrance Scholarship – due April 19th you must apply for this online www.holocaust.hklaw.com , must write a 1200 word essay.
