(These are suggested items that students could follow as a guide. Keep in mind that other important activities should be considered by each student that may not be on this list)

## September

- Check high school credits for graduation.
- Check on required classes needed for graduation.
- Sign up for Credit Recovery Program if additional credits are needed.
- Check on A+ designation requirements
- Start to narrow college choices.
- Register for the October ACT test. Regular deadline is September 16, 2011 and late registration deadline is September 17-30, 2011

## October

- Write a personal resume for jobs and college applications.
- Continue to narrow college choice.
- College application processes (apply or inform guidance office).
- Take ACT test October 22, 2011
- Write a personal essay that can be used for scholarship applications Subject: possible plans, goals, and future plans.. past accomplishments, activities, and experiences.
- October 5, 2011 Jostens will hand out packets for ordering graduation items (announcements, cap and gown).
- October 11, 2011 at 7:30 a.m. Jostens will return to take orders for graduation items.

## November

- Should have made your decision of what college you will be attending.
- Continue application process.
- Register for December ACT test. Regular deadline is November 4, 2011 and Late registration is November 5-18, 2011
- Research Career on the internet. Can use Missouri Connections [missouriconnections.org](http://missouriconnections.org)

## December

- Continue to narrow college choice.
- Complete application process.
- Take ACT if registered December 10, 2011
- Check on second semester schedule-required classes.
- Enjoy Christmas break
- Sign up for Night school in the counselor's office if you failed any classes first semester.
- Check name for diploma

## January

- Check on grades for first semester.
- Sign up for night school or zero hour to make up credits lost from first semester.
- Complete college application process.
- Start FAFSA process (fafsa.gov)
- Apply for scholarships you qualify for.
- Check to make sure on a+ mentoring hours. If not talk to the A+ coordinator or counselor.
- Register for the Act if you are planning on taking the test in February. Regular deadline is January 13, 2012 and Late Registration is January 14-20, 2012
- 1/25/12 Pictures taken for senior composites

## February

- Take ACT (if registered) February 11, 2012
- Continue to complete scholarship applications.  
2/15 Makeup pictures for senior composites  
2/17/2012 Senior Pictures due for yearbook

## March

- College application should be completed.
- Financial Aid (FAFSA) process should be completed.
- Continue to complete scholarship applications.
- Turn in verification of social security to Mrs. Wells if seeking A+ designation.
- Complete application for housing, student work program, etc. to the college you plan on attending.
- Register for the ACT for the April test. Regular deadline is March 9, 2012 and the late fee is March 10-23, 2012.

## April

- Check on grades for high school classes.
- Continue scholarship application process.
- Take the ACT if registered April 14, 2012
- Prepare graduation announcements.
- Check on pre-enrollment dates at college.
- Start summer job process (if planning on working).

## May

- Turn in your final transcript request to the guidance office.
- Check on high school required classes.
- Continue scholarship process.
- Register for June ACT. Regular registration is May 4, 2012 and Late Registration is May 5-18, 2012.
- Prepare and enjoy Graduation!!!!

- 5/16/2012 Senior Awards Night 7:00p.m. @ the Middle School
- 5/19/2012 Graduation at 7:00p.m. @ the Middle School

## June
