

College Requirements

Central Methodist University- applicants must have completed a college preparatory program with a 2.5 GPA, score of 21 or higher on ACT or 1410 on the SAT II exam.

Math-3 units

Science – 3 units

Social Studies-3 units

Foreign Language-1 unit

College of the Ozarks-applicants must score 19 on the ACT and be at the top half of graduating class.

Columbia College- must have a 2.5 *grade point average, rank at the top half of graduating class, and score at the 50th percentile on the ACT.*

Drury University-*must write a 2-3 page essay, score a 25 on ACT.*

East Central College- *may have to take a placement test*

Southeast Missouri State University-

Option 1-ACT score of 21, 2.0 GPA, 17 units of high school core curriculum

Option 2- 18+ on the ACT, 2.5 GPA and 17 units of high school core curriculum.

Language Arts-4 units (2 emphasizing compositions or writing skills, one may be speech or debate)

Math-3 units (Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, Trig and Calculus)

Social Studies-3 units

Science-3 units (biology, chemistry, physics, botany, zoology, A& P. one must be a lab

Fine art-1 unit

Additional: 3 units of foreign language and/or combinations of two or more from the above areas.

Saint Louis college of Pharmacy-23 on ACT (minimum ACT math sub score of 24: minimum sub score of 21 of English, Science and Reading), 3.0 GPA, rank in the upper 50% of graduating class.

Recommended by not required; 1 unit of Physics, additional units in subjects listed above or other math and science classes.

Language Arts-4 units (one of which can be speech or debate: 2 units emphasizing composition or writing skills.

Science-3 units (the three units of science **MUST** include a laboratory course and **MUST** include units from at least two of the following areas: Physical science, biology, physics, Chemistry and Earth Sciences
